SPURIOUS PASSAGES OF THE NEW TESTAMENT for BEREANS

"On Authority of Prof. C. Tischendorf's Notes on the Readings of the Two Oldest Greek MSS [manuscripts] – The Sinaitic and the Vatican #1209

"The following words, found in our Common Version, are not found in the oldest MSS, and are evidently no part of the Divine Word. Let each Berean go through his Bible, pencil in hand, and mark out these words: then read the passages affected and note the improvement. This list comprises all the important interpolations discovered to date.

"The compiler has condensed this list time and again until what remains represents about all there is of value to us in the Tischendorf work. From the compiler's point of view there exist very good reasons why everything in this list should be crossed out of our Bibles. Thus: when the interpolations are eliminated from Mark 14:30, 68, 72, the account agrees exactly with that given by the other evangelists. Or take Luke 23:34; history shows that the Jews have been obliged as a race to expiate their crime. Or take John 4:9: it does not agree at all with Luke 9:52, which shows that even the Lord himself did have such dealings. I have omitted from this list the dozens of interpolations made by early copyists with the aim of making all the narratives uniform, and the hundreds of non-essential words, the addition of which did not in my judgment affect the purity of the message."

REVISIONS SPURIOUS PASSAGES OF THE NEW TESTAMENT for BEREANS

This list, from 1907, based on Tischendorf's Tauchnitz edition (in English, 1869), is here revised for **still more ancient manuscripts** discovered and published up to the end of the twentieth century. It also corrects some mistakes made in the 1907 list

The following verses have been necessarily deleted from the C.J. Woodworth list:

Matt. 6:25, 23:35, 24:10, 27:52; Mark 7:14, 10:30, 14:30, 14:72; Luke 16:16, 17:12, 18:11, 23:5, 24:42; John 1:25, 4:9, 5:25, 19:23, 21:25 (genuineness confirmed by a recently-published 3rd century papyrus, P¹⁰⁹); Acts 15:32; I Peter 2:5; Rev.1:17, 5:3, 5:13, 6:2, 9:4, 16:11, 18:22 (And the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee *), 21:26.

The following verses have been deleted from the original list for other causes:

Rev. 18:22 (*omit* of whatsoever craft he be?)*

Thus, at least 25% of the 1907 list had recommended changes that should not be made.

The Epistles to Timothy, the latter part of Hebrews [9:14 - end], and all of Revelation, are missing from the Vatican MS.No. 1209, having been lost during the centuries since it was written

The Sinaitic MS is perfect and complete and is the oldest known copy of the Scriptures, having been written (it is believed) in the year 331 AD [it is now thought to have been a few decades later].
